Collect all dots! In this manual we'll show you step by step how to assemble your DotDotDo® and hang it up with ease. Before you know it, your DotDotDo® will be shining on your wall!

What you'll need?



Layout plan



Dots



Fillers



Mounting dots



Pencil



Painter's tape

Handy extra

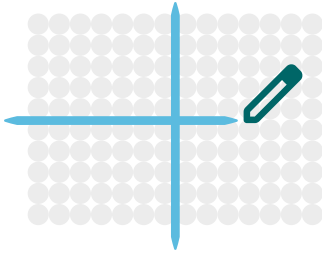
This is what you've received from us:

1. A layout plan for your DotDotDo®
2. Numbered dots
3. Small filler pieces for the dots along the edges
4. Mounting dots

Handy extra: use painter's tape to mark your wall. This makes hanging everything much easier.

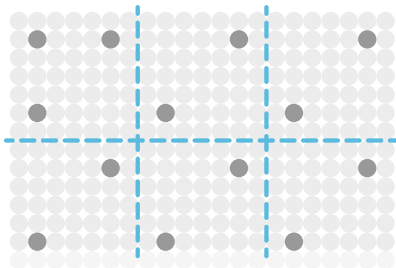
Before you start... Read through this entire manual first so you'll know exactly what to do. Also make sure you have a clean, dust-free, and flat surface. A table is ideal, but the floor works too. Gather your dots and place them in order.

Step 1 – Plan your layout



Grab your layout plan. We've already divided your plan into tiles for you. This way you'll build your DotDotDo® in parts, which makes it much easier to mount on the wall later.

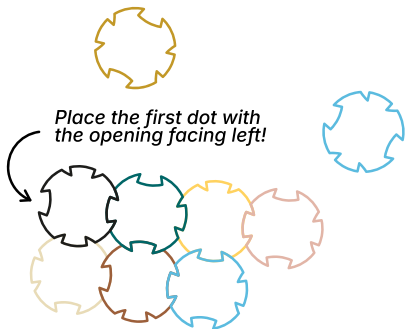
Depending on the size of your DotDotDo®, some tiles may be larger or smaller.



The quantities are shown as an example

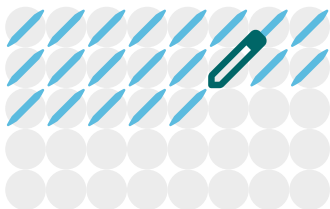
On your layout plan, you'll also see dots with a grey background. These are the dots where you'll place the mounting circles later on. But don't worry, we'll explain that in detail later in this guide.

Step 2 – Time to puzzle!



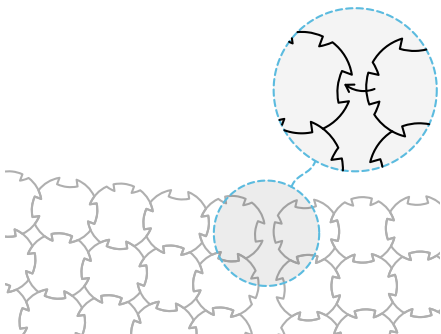
Place the first dot with the opening facing left!

Assemble the dots following your plan. Make sure the numbers on the back of the dots face downward. Start with the tile in the top-left corner. Place the first dot with the opening facing left and work from top-left to bottom-right.

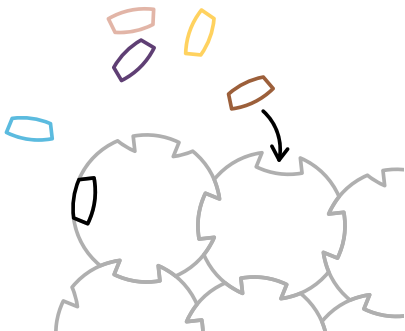


Tip: Cross off the dots on your plan as you place them to keep track of your progress.

Keep going!

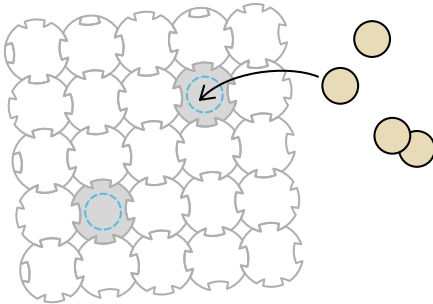


Complete the remaining tiles in the same way.
As you puzzle, make sure the tiles that connect fit neatly together.



Once all tiles are complete, finish the outer tiles by pressing the small filler pieces into the openings of the dots along the edges, creating a clean finish.

Step 3 – Prepare the mounting

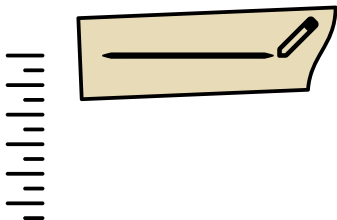


All done puzzling? Then flip your tiles over. Take the mounting circles and stick them onto the dots marked in dark grey on your layout plan.

Important: press them firmly in place for a few seconds and rub over them well, so the adhesive layer bonds optimally to the dot.

Then flip the tiles back over and place them loosely next to one another. This already gives you a great first impression of your DotDotDo®. Don't forget to take a moment to enjoy it ;-)

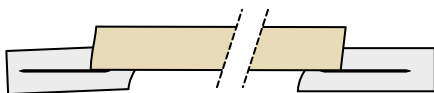
Step 4 – Prepare your wall



Time to choose the perfect spot for your DotDotDo®. Make sure the wall is clean, grease-free, and not too rough. Determine where the top-left corner of your DotDotDo® will be. Mark this spot using a piece of painter's tape.

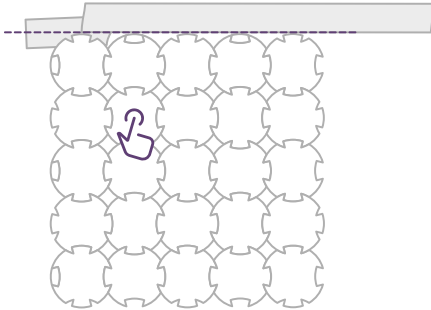
Do the same for the top-right corner.

Check that both markings are at the same height. This helps you hang your DotDotDo® perfectly straight.



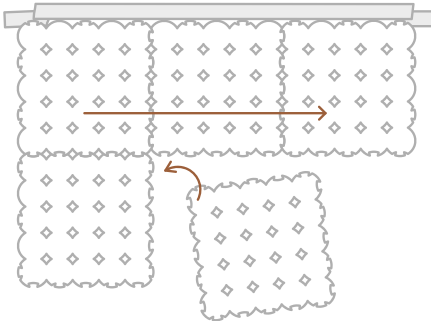
Next, stretch a piece of painter's tape between the two marks. This will be your guide while hanging.

Step 5 – Hang your DotDotDo®

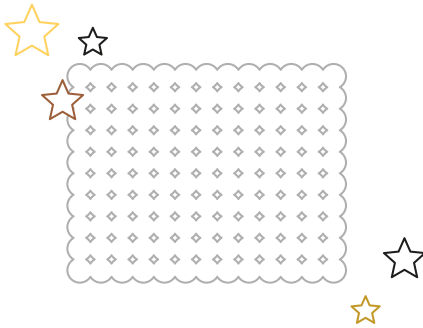


Take the tile that goes in the top-left position. Remove the protective film from the mounting circles and stick the tile right below the left marking on the wall.

Important: firmly on the mounting points for a few seconds. These are the dots with mounting circles. This helps them adhere properly to the wall.



Next, take the tile that goes directly to the right of the first one. Remove the protective film and press it into the edge of the first tile. Keep the mounting points slightly away from the wall for now and make sure the tile is neatly aligned with the painter's tape. Then press firmly on the mounting points so they adhere properly to the wall.

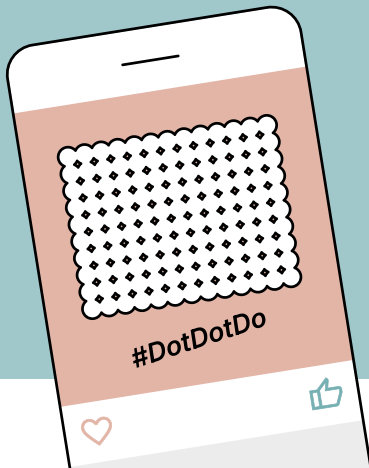


Continue building your DotDotDo® tile by tile. Again, work from top-left to bottom-right. When your DotDotDo® is fully mounted, gently remove the painter's tape from the wall.

Et voilà... *DotDotDone!*

Tip: after one day, check your DotDotDo® again and press the dots with mounting rounds firmly once more for extra-strong adhesion.

Step 6 – Share your creation!
